2023 QUEENSLAND JUNIOR TEAM COACH ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Competition	Japan Junior Olympic Cup, Tokyo 22 – 26 August 2023
Selection	Once the swimmers have been selected the SQ Head Coach and selection committee will select the team coaches based on the: • Athlete/s selected on the Queensland Team • Needs of the Queensland team • The availability of the home coaches and home assistant coaches • The overall development of Queensland coaches • Previous experience • Coaches not selected as a team coach on a 2023 Swimming Australia team may be considered for the Queensland team All team coaches must have: • Demonstrated involvement with SQ Athlete & Coach Development activities • Demonstrated experience in coaching athletes to a level commensurate with the needs of the team
Eligibility	To be considered for selection a coach must: Be a current financial member of SCTA Be up to date with all Swimming Australia Coach accreditation requirements Be available to fulfil all team commitments
Team Commitments	 Available 17 – 27 August 2023 (dates TBC) Training day TBC Comply with the SQ Code of Conduct All coaches must conduct themselves in a proper manner, as not to bring themselves or Swimming Queensland into disrepute
Note	 SQ may amend the selection criteria at any time at its discretion and can make any necessary changes to the coaching staff based on the needs of the team The selection committee retains the right to select the most suitable coach based on the coaches experience and knowledge where they may not meet all the criteria The selection committee retains the right to select a coach based on the coaches experience, knowledge and development where they may not have an athlete selected on the team The selection committee retains the right to select a Mentee Coach based on the needs of that coach for further experience, knowledge and development. They must have demonstrated prior involvement in development activities
