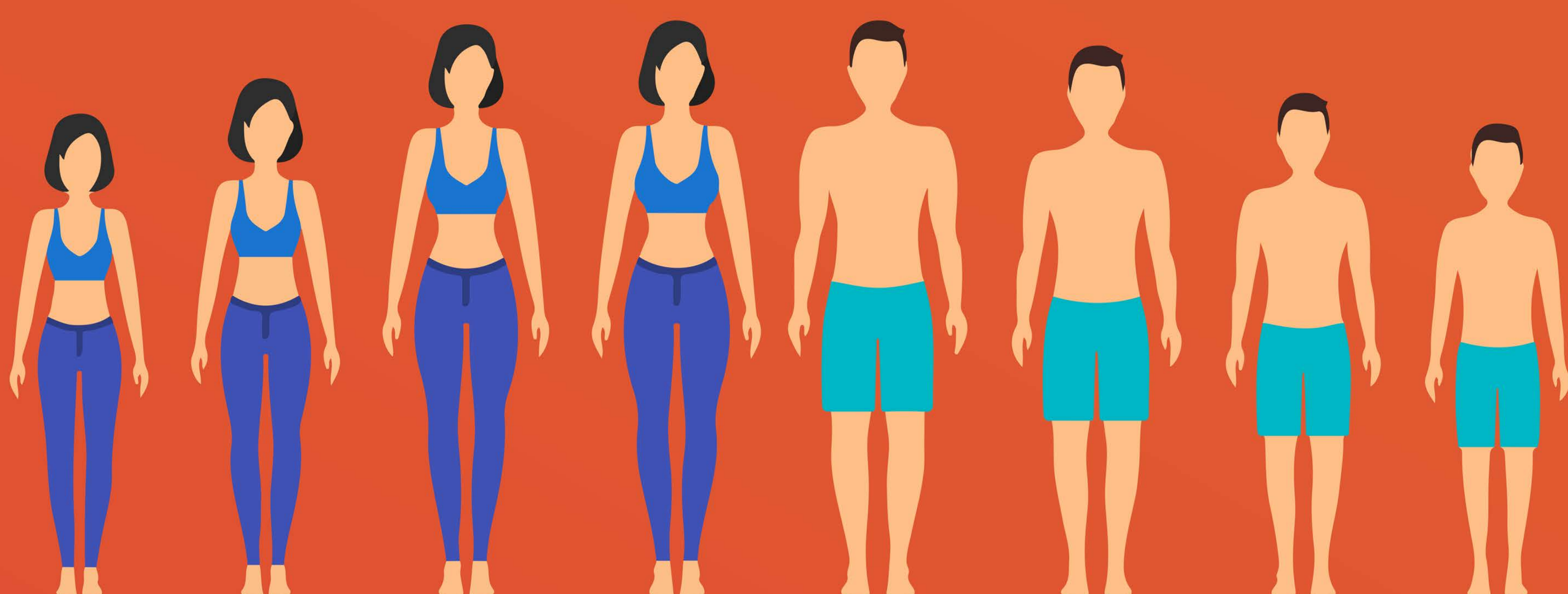

Timing and speed of growth and maturation can vary considerably

A way to assess a child's growth and maturation stage is by estimating the time point which maximum growth rates occur (point of peak growth).

We can assess time and speed of growth and maturation by measuring:

- Standing height (stature)
 - Child and both biological parents
- Sitting height
- Weight

We will be measuring these at the station:
