Competition	World Aquatics Swimming World Cup Tour 15 – 27 October 2024
Selection	Once the swimmers have been selected the SQ Head coach and selection committee will select the team coaches based on the:  • Athlete/s selected on the Queensland Team  • Needs of the Queensland team  • The availability of the home coaches and home assistant coaches  • The overall development of Queensland coaches  • Previous experience
	<ul> <li>All team coaches must have:</li> <li>Demonstrated involvement with SQ Athlete &amp; Coach Development activities</li> <li>Demonstrated experience in coaching athletes to a level commensurate with the needs of the team</li> </ul>
Eligibility	<ul> <li>To be considered for selection a coach must:</li> <li>Be a current financial member of SCTA</li> <li>Be up to date with all Swimming Australia Coach accreditation requirements</li> <li>Be available to fulfil all team commitments</li> </ul>
Team Commitments	<ul> <li>Team travel 15 – 27 October 2024</li> <li>Team Training Day TBC</li> <li>Comply with the SQ Code of Conduct</li> <li>All coaches must conduct themselves in a proper manner so as not to bring themselves or Swimming Queensland into disrepute</li> </ul>
Note	<ul> <li>SQ may amend the selection criteria at any time at its discretion and can make any necessary changes to the coaching staff based on the needs of the team</li> <li>The selection committee retains the right to select the most suitable coach based on the coaches experience and knowledge where they may not meet all the criteria</li> <li>The selection committee retains the right to select a coach based on the coaches experience, knowledge and development where they may not have an athlete selected on the team</li> <li>The selection committee retains the right to select a Mentee coach based on the needs of that coach for further experience, knowledge and development. They must have demonstrated prior involvement in development activities</li> </ul>
