

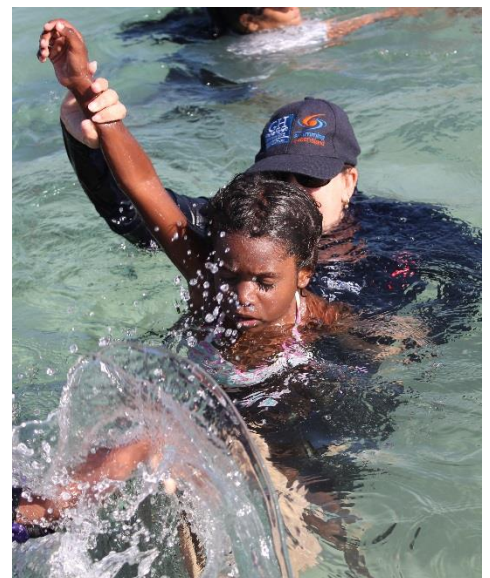
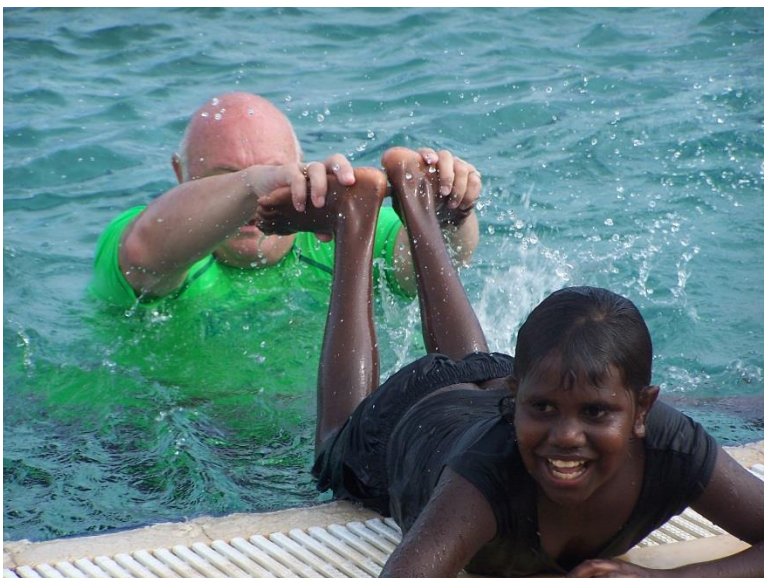
Swimming in Queensland is a fully inclusive and accessible activity that provides enjoyment, opportunity and a healthy activity for all participants. Swimming participation assists to deliver healthier, happier and safer communities and Swimming Queensland continually strives to achieve sustainable communities.

Program Aims

- Provide a safer water-aware school and community.
- Foster healthier and fitter community.
- Improve school attendance.
- Develop swimming competition opportunities and pathways at school and in the community.
- Create family orientated activities with links to community, school, recreation and council plans.
- Facilitate community cohesion and a more socially engaged community.

Program Activities include:

- Teaching fundamental aquatic skills to the general community - e.g. teaching an adult who is apprehensive in the water to relax and get to the edge safely.
- The delivery of accredited training courses within the community
- Implementation of aquatic based swimming and water safety programs in association with key community stakeholders.
- Providing hands-on, practical training and tuition through Swimming Queensland visits.
- Providing Communities with swimming competition pathways.
- The development and co-ordination of annual community swimming carnivals and invite other communities to attend.
- Assisting with forming a swimming club in partnership with Regional Swimming Associations.
